- Bus Safety Notice! The council has contacted us about children from Kaharoa School being nearly hit by vehicles when crossing Hamurana Rd after getting off the school bus (near the corner of Ward Rd and Hamurana Rd).
 - The council suggests that parents of children under 10 should be parking at the dairy and crossing the road to wait for their child/ren on the lake side of Hamurana Rd NOT calling their child across the road to them - especially in wet conditions when everyone is in a hurry because of the rain.
 - A reminder to all that the road rules are 'Either way is 20kph' past a stopped school bus.
