Times Tables Rockstars North Island Competition

As part of our commitment to make maths exciting and high profile in our school, we are taking part in a friendly competition involving schools in North Island. The competition runs for three days, from 8am Tuesday 12 May to 6pm Thursday 14 May 2026. It's all done online via play.ttrockstars.com

Children can play in any game mode with every correct answer to a multiplication or division question, earning themselves, their class and the school a point. The **Times Tables Rock Stars** platform will calculate the class average based on the number of correct answers per student in the class. Winning classes in the school and in the competition as a whole will be the ones with the highest average.

To support player wellbeing, there is a daily time limit of 30-minutes per player. Once the player goes beyond 30-minutes of play on that day, they will still earn coins but will no longer earn points towards the competition. In the spirit of the competition, please don't play on their behalf but by all means encourage and support them to the extent that it doesn't cause high stress levels or impact on family plans.

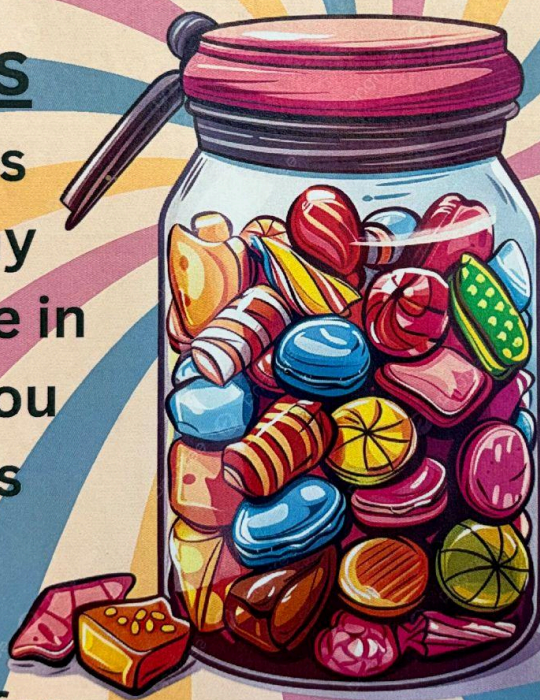
