Kim Dalton	<p>We will use Hapara and the G suite to share our programmes with students. This will be organised into weeks and subjects. Students will have access to resources online, complete work in Google Drive, submit it on Hapara and use Google Calendar/Hangouts to collaborate/discuss and share learning.</p>
Rm Totara	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Writing- models of writing shared through Hapara. Students highlight according to teacher prompts. Students set a goal and write on Google Docs. Writing is then submitted on Hapara and feedback given by the teacher.
Denise Sharp	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Maths Question and follow up activities shared on Hapara. Students can use Google Hangouts to discuss and share their strategies and work through problems together. Submit work online for feedback. ● Reading- as part of research from projects. Journals/articles accessed online with follow up activities (when we see fit), personal reading everyday. ● Students will continue to work on their projects, using workbooks and rubrics online to guide their work.
